# CIVIL SERVICE AND VEHICLE POLICY AMENDMENTS

## **CIVIL SERVICE RULES**

#### Councilperson Zucal – Proposed Amendment:

I make a motion amend Bill 69 by deleting the proposed changes related to the application for Captain; in effect, deleting the following and make the necessary changes to the title of the bill:

b. an applicant for the position of Captain shall have a minimum of five (5) years of experience as a Sergeant in his or her respective grade in the Allentown Police Department and twelve (12) years of service with the Allentown Police Department.

- 1) Captain:
  - a. an applicant for the position of Captain shall have a minimum of one (1) year of experience as a Lieutenant in his or her respective grade in the Allentown Police Department; or
  - b. <u>an applicant for the position of Captain shall have a minimum of five (5) years of experience as a Sergeant in his or her respective grade in the Allentown Police Department and twelve (12) years of service with the Allentown Police Department.</u>

#### Councilperson Robinson's Proposed Amendment

I make a motion to add this as Section Four to Bill 69 (obviously this is not needed if Mr. Zucal's amendment passes.)

SECTION FOUR: <u>The Police Chief shall report to City Council on the effect of the change to the provisions</u> for the position of <u>Captain (1b)</u>, no later than one year after the effective date of this ordinance.

### **Bill 70 VEHICLE POLICY**

Councilperson Zucal's Proposed Amendment:

I make a motion to do the following:

- 1. In every instance where the number of take home vehicles is listed at 30, change the number of vehicles permitted to be taken home to 17 at B 7; C-1; C-3
- 2. In C1 include the following after The Mayor shall have the authority to assign City personnel to the seventeen (17) take-home vehicles mandated by City Council.

The 17 vehicles shall be assigned to the following positions: Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police (2); Police Captain On Call; K-9 Unit (4); Fire Chief; Assistant Fire Chief (2); EMS Coordinator; Public Works Director; Streets Department Superintendent; Facilities Manager; Managing Director; Mayor. Motorcycles will be allowed to be taken home for special events with the permission of the Police Chief and or designee.

(The Criminal Investigation Division are not part of the original limitation).

3. Under Use of City Vehicles add 8 to read as follows:

8. <u>Take home vehicles shall be allowed only for employees that live in the city or within a five mile</u> radius of the boundaries of the city and in the case of K-9 Units, within a ten mile radius.
