AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2019 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of One Hundred Twenty Thousand (\$120,000.00) Dollars from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for the Early Intervention Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2019 General Fund in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand (\$120,000.00) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.

Purpose of the ordinance is to appropriate the revenue and expenses for the Early Intervention Program Grant. The \$120,000 grant is funded through the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.
