AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2019 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) from Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) toward the construction of a skatepark at Jordan Park.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2019 Capital Fund in the amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) reflecting receipt of monies from PA DCNR toward the construction of a skatepark at Jordan Park.
