AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2019 Solid Waste Fund Budget by transferring Six Hundred Forty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Seven (\$642,857) Dollars from the 2019 General Fund to the 2019 Solid Waste Fund for the third loan payment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes the transfer from the General Fund, General and Civic Program in the following manner:

Interfund Transfer

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes an increase to unappropriated balance of the Solid Waste Fund as the result of a transfer from the General Fund in the following manner:

Solid Waste Fund

085-2660 Transfer In \$ 642,857

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

With the refinancing of debt the City is benefiting from a savings in the Debt Fund. This savings has allowed the third loan payment to be made to the Solid Waste Fund as outlined in the ordinance.
