## RESOLUTION

R - 2019

## Introduced by City Council on June 19, 2019

Allentown City Council authorizes the Controller's Office and the EAC to conduct a comprehensive carbon footprint of the city and calls upon the EAC to devise a climate action plan to be developed and present to council no later than December 2019.

## Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the scientific evidence for warming of the climate system is an unequivocal fact; and

**WHEREAS**, the planet's average surface temperature has risen about 1.62 degrees Fahrenheit (0.9 degrees Celsius) since the late 19th century, a change driven largely by increased carbon dioxide and other human-made emissions into the atmosphere; and

**WHEREAS**, most of the warming occurred in the past 35 years, with the five warmest years on record taking place since 2010; and

WHEREAS, human generated greenhouse gas emission from fossil fuel combustion is a major cause; and

**WHEREAS**, we are experiencing warming oceans, shrinking ice sheets, retreating glaciers, increases in sea level, ocean acidification and extreme weather events; and

**WHEREAS**, climate change is the foremost existential threat (along with Donald Trump) to the global community today; and

**WHEREAS**, Allentown City Council supports local solutions to deal with climate change.

**NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Allentown City Council hereby asks for the Controller's Office and the EAC to conduct a comprehensive carbon footprint of the city and calls upon the EAC to devise a climate action plan to be developed and present to council no later than December 2019.
