Due to an unanticipated increase in Pennsylvania's apportionment from the Federal Historic Preservation Fund (HPF) for fiscal year 2019, I have the pleasure of informing you that the City's FY2019 CLG grant award has been increased. The increased HPF funding has allowed the PA SHPO to provide an additional \$3,000 in grant funding for the previously approved project, bringing the total award to \$25,000. This increased funding amount will not require matching funds beyond what was provided for in the initial grant agreement. An amended grant agreement and project budget will be prepared and sent to you in the near future. I trust this is welcome news and that the funding will enable the City to continue doing great work on behalf of its historic places.
