It is with great enthusiasm that I am submitting the name of Glenn Granitz, Jr. to become the city's Chief of Police.

Granitz joined the department in 2001 and graduated from the Allentown Police Academy. He was assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division as a detective in 2005. In 2008 he joined the Lehigh County Homicide Task Force and was involved in multiple homicide arrests and convictions in cases dating as far back as 1998.

In 2010 Granitz was promoted to Detective/Sergeant in the Criminal Investigations Division overseeing investigations in the areas of homicides, robberies, sexual assaults, property crimes and more.

In 2013 Grantiz was selected to lead the Youth 7 Community Services Division of APD, evaluating and assigning investigations and supervising all youth detectives and school resource officers. Additionally, during that time he oversaw APD's Gang Intelligence initiatives.

Granitz was promoted to lieutenant in May 2015 and was assigned to the third platoon. He was promoted to captain in August 2017 serving center city, overseeing the fourth platoon and all officers assigned to patrol the center city area, including the Center City Bike Unit.

Granitz holds a B. S. from Saint Joseph's University and an M. S. in Criminal Justice Administration from University of Cincinnati. He has taken three courses toward his doctorate and is currently obtaining a bachelor's degree in Human Resource Management. Granitz is also a graduate of the Northwestern University – School of Police Staff & Command. He has completed the FBI-LEEDA Command Leadership training and the FBI-LEEDA Executive Leadership Training, among multiple other law enforcement supervisory trainings.
