AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the City of Allentown, County of Lehigh and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, revising Article 400 Department of Parks and Recreation Fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the Fees portion of Article 400, Allentown Codified Ordinances, be amended as follows:

• Summary and Facts of the Bill

Increase the 9 hole and 18 hole cart fees by \$1 and also instituting mandatory carts on Saturdays and Sundays until Noon. Remove the walking fee of \$8 before 11am on weekends and holidays.

• Purpose – Please include the following in your explanation:

• What does the Bill do – what are the specific goals/tasks the bill seek to accomplish

Increase Golf Cart Rental Fees by \$1 for both 9 hole and 18 hole. The 9 hole rate will now be \$10 and the 18 hole rate will be \$18. Additionally, carts will now be mandatory until noon on Saturday, Sunday and all holidays.

• What are the Benefits of doing this/Down-side of doing this

Increasing the cart fees will put the Golf Course in a more competitive position with surrounding golf courses.

Mandatory carts on the weekends and holidays will vastly improve pace of play at the course during prime hours of operation.

• How does this Bill related to the City's Vision/Mission/Priorities

Increasing the cart fees will help to achieve the City's goal of the golf course of remaining a self-sustaining operation. The fees accurately align the course's fees with other courses in the area.

Making carts mandatory on Saturday, Sunday and holidays will help improve the pace of play on the course on some of the busiest days of the week. In doing so, it will create a better overall user experience for golfers. The overwhelming majority of courses in the area have instituted similar rules in order to create a better experience for customers on the weekends.

Increasing the fees will align the Municipal Golf Course with other courses in the area. It will also allow the course to maintain it fiscal goals for the 2020 season.
