The street was created by the Hamilton Park Plan dated May 1924 as part of South Whitehall Township and was recorded in the Office of the Lehigh County Recorder of Deeds in Map Book 2 Page 171. The subject portion of South Whitehall Township was annexed by the City of Allentown by Ordinance 2556 on January 20th, 1930.




