# AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2020 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars and Forty Cents (\$7,364.40). This was the result of payment in lieu of tree plantings from City Center Investment Corp., Urban Residential Properties, LLC and Luis C. Groff. Funds will be used for the purchase of new street trees.

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2020 Capital Fund in the amount of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars and Forty Cents (\$7,364.40) reflecting receipt of monies for payments in lieu of tree plantings.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund as follows:

This bill reflects the receipts totaling of \$7,364.40 from the contributors for the purchase of street trees by the City for their respective projects. They are as follows:

Louis C. Gross in the amount of \$1,332.00 for the land development at 902 S. 10th Street;

City Center Investment Corp. in the amount of \$2,732.40 for City Place final major land development; and

Urban Residential Properties, LLC in the amount of \$3,300 for Riverview Lofts Land Development.
