AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2020 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Seven (\$2,650,167) Dollars. This was the result of payment from UGI for the construction of ADA handicap ramps, milling and paving streets under the City's Utility Paving Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2020 Capital Fund in the amount of Two Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Seven (\$2,650,167) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from UGI.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund as follows:

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
