Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

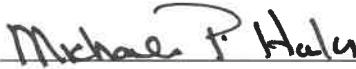

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates the Mayor and Finance Director as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for One Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars (\$188,127.00) in ARLE Grant funds to the Department of transportation.

The City is submitting an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for an Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) Transportation Enhancement Grant. We are requesting \$188,127.00 in grant funds, which would support installation of the flashing pedestrian school crossing light at Martin Luther King Boulevard and 4th Street (by Building 21 and Parkettes). City match will be \$20,903.00.
