Transfers: \$20,000 in Health – To fund temporary contact tracers for COVID-19 disease investigation from Account #000-09-0908-0019-46 (Other Contract Services) to Account #000-09-0908-0019-04 (Temporary Wages) and **\$12,000.00 in Health** – To Fund an Expert Consultant for the Public Health and Safety Project to Reduce Opioid Use from Account #000-09-0908-0002-46 (Other Contract Services) to Account #000-09-0908-0002-04 (Temporary Wages).
