AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2020 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Twenty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$22,892.38) from PPL in the form of a rebate from the LED Street Light conversion phase one project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2020 Capital Fund in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$22,892.38) from PPL.
