# Recognizing Suicide Prevention Month

## Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

**WHEREAS**, September is National Suicide Prevention Month and Allentown City Council desires to recognize **Suicide Prevention Month**; and

**WHEREAS**, all month, mental health advocates, prevention organizations, survivors, allies, and community members unite to promote suicide prevention awareness; and

WHEREAS, suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, in the state of Pennsylvania, one person dies by suicide every four hours, making it the second leading cause of death for ages 15 – 34 and the 4<sup>th</sup> leading cause of death for ages 35 - 54; and

WHEREAS, nearly five million people in the United States have lost a loved one to suicide; and

WHEREAS, during Suicide Prevention Month, let us take time to remember those affected by suicide, to raise awareness, and to focus efforts on treatment to those who need it the most; and

WHEREAS, local and statewide suicide prevention efforts should be developed and encouraged to the maximum extent possible; and

**NOW, THEREFORE ALLENTOWN CITY COUNCIL** on Wednesday, September 2, 2020 does recognize **Suicide Prevention Month** to spread awareness, take time to reach out to those in need and help people understand the severity of this cause.
