## AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2020 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Four Thousand Thirteen Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$4,013.70). This was the result of payment in lieu of tree plantings from Victory Real Estate Development. Funds will be used for the purchase of new street trees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2020 Capital Fund in the amount of Four Thousand Thirteen Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$4,013.70) reflecting receipt of monies for payments in lieu of tree plantings.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Fund as follows:

#### Shade Tree Revitalization

SECTION THREE: That this Ordinance will take effect ten (10) days after final passage.

SECTION FOUR: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
