INTRODUCED BY THE ADMINISTRATION

DECEMBER 21, 2020

AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2020 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a transfer of Three Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Dollars and Ninety-Two Cents (\$332,470.92) as a transfer of funds from multiple project accounts to provide Bridge Repair Funds. Bureau of Engineering is supervising and monitoring the funds. Also, corrects negative balances in projects 1753 – American Parkway NE and 1282 – Hamilton Street Safety Improvement From 10th Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the City Council authorizes a transfer of the appropriated balance of the Capital Fund in the amount of Three Hundred Thirty-Two Four Hundred Seventy Dollars and Ninety-Two Cents (\$332,470.92) as a transfer of funds from multiple project accounts to the Bridge Repairs account to provide bridge repairs throughout the City.

- **Summary and Facts of the Bill**

This Bill will transfer funds from multiple projects to the Bridge Repairs account. The funds are needed to address deficiencies at multiple bridge locations as cited by the NBIS (National Bridge Inventory System) inspections performed under the direction of PennDOT as well as damages that have resulted from Hurricane Isaias.

The Bill will provide funding to address deficiencies at our existing bridges. The benefits of well maintained bridges is lower costs of repair with regular maintenance. Addressing issues early prevent costly ones later. Properly maintaining bridge infrastructure is critical to the transportation operations in the City.

The costs for the multiple scour protection projects resulting from hurricane Isaias as well as PennDOT required bridge approach guiderail improvements and other repairs will quickly use the funds that are being transferred and budgeted. However, the plan is to address the worst issues first and after the monies are expended re-assess to determine the balance of funding needed for any remaining deficiency correction projects.

The funds to be used for the transfers are stated in the ordinance. The funds are being transferred from completed roadway projects. The completed roadway project accounts will be closed upon transfer of the funds.
