AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 Capital Fund Budget by transferring Two Hundred Forty-Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Sixty-One Cents (\$246,171.61) from Capital Project 1227 – Automatic Meter Reading and Capital Project 1743 – Mechanical Renovations Wastewater Plant to Capital Project 1805 – Emergency Water Repairs to correct a negative balance in this account.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That the City Council authorizes a transfer of the appropriated balance of the Capital Fund in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-Six Thousand One Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Sixty-One Cents (\$246,171.61) as a transfer of funds from Capital Project 1227 and Capital Project 1743 as follows:
