AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 Capital Projects Fund and the 2021 Trexler Fund to provide for a transfer of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars to continue repairs on various WPA structures throughout the park system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund to the following account:

Move funds from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund and place those funds in the WPA Repairs capital project. A total of \$60,000 needs to be appropriated into the Capital account in order to continue repairs on various WPA structures throughout the park system.
