AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Two (\$195,542) Dollars from Lehigh County Authority (LCA) to make road improvements throughout the LCA restoration work area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2021 Capital Fund in the amount of One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Two (\$195,542) Dollars from a contribution from Lehigh County Authority.

Bill would authorize the acceptance of \$195,542.00 from LCA that the City has negotiated for the purpose of construction of ADA handicap ramps and for milling and paving streets under the City's "Utility Paving Program".
