AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 General Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Fifty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Two (\$56,572) Dollars from the United States Department of Justice through the Emergency Supplemental Funding program known as the CARES Act to the City of Allentown for COVID-19 related purchases.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the 2021 General Fund in the amount of Fifty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Two (\$56,572) Dollars reflecting receipt of monies from the Pennsylvania Department of Justice Grant.

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund as follows:

Purpose of the ordinance is to appropriate the revenue and expenses for the 2020 Covid 19 JAG grant that will reimburse expenses related to the Covid 19 pandemic back to January 20, 2020 and fund additional items related to the pandemic up to \$169,095.

This City has been allocated \$169,095 by the Department of Justice through the Emergency Supplemental Funding program known as the CARES act. The budget is broken down into a two year period allowing for \$112,523 to be utilized this year and the remainder budgeted of \$56,572 for 2021. This funding will allow for reimbursement of expenses relating to COVID 19 back to January 20, 2020 and to cover any expected costs relating to the pandemic for this year and next year.
