AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 Trexler Fund Budget to provide for a supplemental appropriation of Three Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents. (\$301,767.50) from the Trexler Trust as the balance of the 2021 contribution per General Trexler's will.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes an increase to the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund in the amount of Three Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$301,767.50) reflecting receipt of funds from the Trexler Trust for their annual contribution:

006-6689 Trexler Maintenance Grant \$ 301,767.50

SECTION TWO: That City Council authorizes a supplemental appropriation from the unappropriated balance of the Trexler Fund in the amount of Three Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$301,767.50) as follows:

Accept and appropriate \$301,767.50 received from the Trexler Trust to the 2021 operating budget. This amount reflects the additional contribution that is over the \$1,694,794. originally budgeted for 2021. The actual award for 2021 operating costs from the Trexler Trust is \$1,996.561.50.

Appropriate \$60,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-04 (Temp Wages) Required to pay summer help to help with maintenance of the park system.

Appropriate \$30,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-06 (Premium Pay) Needed to cover costs of emergency call outs (downed trees, etc.) and other maintenance needs throughout the parks.

Appropriate \$6,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-30 (Rentals) Needed to pay for various equipment rentals needed for maintenance issues in the parks.

Appropriate \$5,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-42 (Repair and Maintenance) for maintenance repairs needed in various parks.

Appropriate \$10,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-46 (Other Contract Services) for water testing services, GPS services, and other maintenance that will require an outside contractor, etc.

Appropriate \$57,455.20 to 006-08-6761-0001-54 (Repair and Maintenance Supplies) needed to purchase various tools and supplies needed to maintain the parks.

Appropriate \$2,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-56 (Uniforms) covers the cost of uniforms required by the union contract to be purchased by the Department.

Appropriate \$2,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-62 (Fuels, Oils and Lubricants) for the purchase of heating oil, propane and various other needs defined by this account for the park system and its facilities.

Appropriate \$5,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-66 (Chemicals) to obtain fertilizers and other turf maintenance chemicals for the parks.

Appropriate \$35,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-68 (Operating Materials and Supplies) for the purchase of mulch, small equipment, etc. to assist I the maintenance of the park system.

Appropriate \$20,000 to 006-08-6761-0001-72 (Equipment) to purchase new trash receptacles be used in the maintenance of the parks.

Appropriate \$69,312.30 to 006-08-6761-0001-84 (Capital Fund Contribution, as per agreement between Trexler Trust and the City)

• Why should Council unanimously support this bill?

Accepting and appropriating these funds carries out the wishes of General Harry C. Trexler's will by assisting in maintaining and improving the beautiful park system within the City. The funds will meet the 20% obligation the City has for capital projects as per the agreement between the City and the Trexler Trust. The

funds for operations will assist with upgrades and enhancements to the park system and day to day operations.
