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AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2021 General Fund by transferring Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred (\$420,7000) Dollars from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund to enable replacement of the existing chiller and four (4) pumps which are no longer working.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes the transfer from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund in the following manner:

**Public Works  
Building Maintenance**

**000-03-0707-0001-46**

**Other Contract Services**

**\$ 420,700**

SECTION TWO: That pursuant to Section 218 and upon the affirmative vote of six of seven councilpersons, this Ordinance will take effect immediately after final passage.

SECTION THREE: That all Ordinances inconsistent with the above provisions are repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

Providing funds for the replacement of the existing failing chiller and 4 associated pumps.

This existing chiller and 4 related pumps are currently over 20 years old and have been failing over the last several years. Upon starting the unit for the 2021 spring/summer seasons the unit failed to operate beyond the ability to repair it. The new unit with a four year extended warranty on the parts and labor and four chilled water and condensing pumps is estimated to cost \$420,700. This ordinance will allow for the use of funds from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund for this necessary project.

The replacement of the chiller and pumps with newer, more efficient models will save the City money in the cost of operating the unit.
