Introduced by the Administration on September 8, 2021

Authorizes Submission of a Formal Application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development for a Grant of One Million Two Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,232,800.00) to support traffic signal improvements along Hanover Street in Allentown.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown, Lehigh County hereby requests a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$1,232,800 from the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development to support traffic signal improvements on Hanover Street between Albert Street and Wahneta Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Ray O'Connell, Mayor, and Seth O'Neill, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Commonwealth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for One Million Two Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,232,800.00) in Multimodal Transportation Funds to the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development.
