- Buildings and Contents Fire Loss
 - Just over 1.4 million dollars
- Vehicle Fire Loss
 - 125 thousand dollars



2021 Overview

- **Fire Prevention**
 - Home Fire Campaign
 - Red Cross/AFD joint venture to install smoke detectors.
 - Installed approximately 36 detectors and made 22 homes safer within a 4-block radius, which goes to show the potential once we can safely secure volunteers.
