Mr. Lou Hershman, 405 Gilmore Street, stated that tonight the Mayor presented the Budget. He didn't present all the budgets. He asked about the Five Year Capital Plan. He asked about the annual Actuarial Study. He asked about the Operations Manager position and the Charter. When was the last time City Council looked at the personnel code. He asked about amnesty for people that are delinquent for over two years.

Mr. Michael Hanlon stated that it will be introduced tonight.

Mr. Julio Guridy stated that it is every two years.

Mr. Brent Hartzell stated that the city just received the 2016 Actuarial Study from Cheiron.

Mr. Ray O'Connell thanked Mr. Hershman

Mr. Glenn Hunsicker, 844 S. 11th Street, asked about the 2006 Loan Fund and how you will address that next year. He asked if the city will continue to pay interest and principal on that lockbox. He asked if it was legal on what they did.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked Mr. Hartzell to answer the question. He asked has the data been reliable. He suggested to Mr. Hahn to read the auditor's report and the CAFR.

Mr. Brent Hartzell stated that the story of the lockbox is such that at this point we consider that our General Fund reserves and we are treating it as

such. We are always looking to minimize the cost. He stated that anything in which principal is owed we pay timely. The CAFR indicates what we are doing with the money. We keep getting clean opinions.

Mr. Jeff Glazier stated that it is a misconception there. In the non-pooled cash the 2006 Loan Fund is actually an asset. The underline debt that created it would be listed in the Budget Book under Debt Service Fund. He stated that we have discussed this issue at length.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked anyone else for Courtesy of the Floor.

Mr. Tom Hahn, 2016 E. Highland Street, stated that he hold in front of him on page 527 a document that talks about deposits and comingling negative cash balance and temporary balance fund and investment fund. He asked for an update on that report.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked what page from the Charter.

Mr. Roger MacLean stated in the budget book on page 503.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that is the Investment Committee that we formed years ago.

Mr. Craig Freedoland, 517 1/2 N. Howard Street, stated that he appreciates everyone what they do. He spoke about the Allentown Parking Authority and the best way for them to operate. There has to be more solutions. The board hasn't been able to solve concerns and/or problems. He stated that there has to be a better way.

Mr. Daryl Hendricks stated that you can attend the Parking Authority's board meetings.

Mr. Jeffrey Sanchez, 46 N. Tenth Street, stated that he is an out of state investor and having trouble opening his business. It takes too long opening up a business.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that he sees the email chain go back and forth about the permits.

Mr. Brent Hartzell stated that several weeks ago when Mr. Sanchez's issue came before us since business license is under his jurisdiction we are doing nothing in finance to necessarily hold up anything in terms of the business license. The Planning Department was waiting for Mr. Sanchez.

Mr. Ray O'Connell thanked Mr. Sanchez.

Mr. Julio Guridy stated that he called me and asked you to come over. He talked to Mr. Carmen Dragotta. He is going to personally look to see if we need more people. There are issues with the zoning rules and codes that are a little bit more stringent.

Mr. Michael Kaminski, 779 Benton Street, asked about Section 802 and 803 of the City Charter and the submission of a balance budget and Capital Program. He thinks something needs to be added that the public and Council should be the Budget at least 24 hours prior to the Mayor's presentation. He asked about a forensic audit for the city. If we can control the meters on Sunday, can we control the times during the day.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that there is a Bill that we are introducing tonight about the parking. We will look at that stuff. They are good suggestions.

Mr. Robert Trotner, 1920 Whitehall Street, stated that the city's parking ordinance was one of the worst decisions that Council took. He is glad they are revisiting that. He just saw tonight that there is a \$12.5 million Bond Issue that will be discussed tonight.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated \$11.5 million.

Mr. Brent Hartzell stated that it is a refinancing and probably going things before the Lease. It will be introduced tonight and Monday is when this actually come up for discussion. We were able with help from PFM to get interest rate savings. A lot of our debt is at the lowest rate.

Mr. Ray O'Connell stated that it will be discussed Monday. He asked anyone else for Courtesy of the Floor.
