## Resolution #29550

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated that this was released through the formal RFP process. It was advertised at June 30th. The technical proposals were on August 8, and the cost proposals were open on August 23rd. We did issue the tentative award on September 8th contingent on approval at this meeting.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked how much.

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated that there is no cost to the city.

Mr. Brent Hartzell stated that this is one they will be collecting. Based on the collection, they get a portion from that fee. We have been using them up to this point.

Mr. Daryl Hendricks asked what is the portion they get.

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated 15 percent off the claim.

Mr. Julio Guridy stated of the collecting amount.

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated yes.

Mr. Ray O'Connell asked any other questions from my colleagues.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked if there were other proposals.

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated that we received proposals from Source, HOV, Credit Tech and Central Credit Audit Inc. On the technical component, Penn Credit scored significantly better. Penn Credit was not the lowest, but one of the lowest. They were the second lowest and their technical proposal was much better.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked if the city was allowed to do that.

Ms. Beth Ann Strohl stated yes.
