Resolution #30003

Ms. Jessica Baraket stated that this was originally done as RFP #2019-07. It was approved by Council on 6-19-19. The increase is being requested due to the scope of work being altered adding additional services due to the requirements from the city's Public Works Department.

Mr. Julio Guridy asked what is it adding. What was the request adding?

Ms. Jessica Baraket stated that in addition to the project are grandstand structural design, flash pad sanitary stormwater redesign, and a sewer facility planning module which were requirements from the city's Public Works Department.

Ms. Cynthia Mota asked what are the amenities again.

Ms. Karen El-Chaar stated that they are adding to the Valania Park Project: a grandstand design which will fit perfectly and will be a nice amenity for Valania Park by the basketball court. That was not in the original scope of work. They have to do a number of splash pads. They are installing a splash pad/spray park at Valania Park. That is a new amenity which was included. However, we have to do a number of redesigns of the project based on additional stormwater requirements through Public Works and discussions with Engineering to do a number of redesigns. They have a Sewage Facilities Planning Module which is an oversight review activity of the entire by the Pennsylvania DEP. That is a significant expense that was not incorporated into the original contract.

Ms. Cynthia Mota stated that she would like to encourage all Councilmembers to vote yes for this additional improvement. Valania Park is a park that needs a lot of caring. The community feels that Valania Park has been a park that has been neglected in many ways for many years. She stated that she would love to see this happening. This is really what the community wants and also what many of us want. It is for our children.

Mr. Julio Guridy seconded what Ms. Mota said. He thinks it is something that they have been talking about and working on for many months. It is part of what is said last year that they wanted to do and he is glad that it is being constructed. He asked the question because he wanted to know what the new addition was for the \$26,800 as a Change Order.

Mayor Ray O'connell stated that to Ms. Mota, you are right, Valania Park has needed an upgrade for a long, long time. If you are in Allentown and you drive around, he considers Valania Park the heart of the park in the city. We know everyone that goes over there: Hamp, Dan and everybody. It is long overdue.

Mr. Daryl Hendricks stated that at no time has it been more important to have that recreational facilities than now, during this pandemic. As limited as it can be, but exercising one of the most important things for people to do. He agrees with all the comments make so far. He asked if there were any other comments from his colleagues or the public.
