AN ORDINANCE

Amending the 2024 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a transfer of Three Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand (\$378,000.00) Dollars from multiple capital projects into the D&L Trail to use for design of the trail, Mini-Pitch to use for installation of the system, and WPA Structures for repairs of Union Terrace Amphitheater Phase 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a transfer in the following manner:

Transfer \$378,000.00 from multiple capital projects into D&L trail, Mini-Pitch and WPA Structures to use for design of the D&L Trail, installation of the Mini-Pitch system and stone repairs at Union Terrace Park. These funds would be placed in the D&L Trail, Mini-Pitch, and WPA Structures capital projects.
