RESOLUTION

Introduced by the Administration on

Authorizes the sale of Police K9 Dingo to his handler Police Officer Joseph Krebs

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown,

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown owns a police dog, K9 Officer Dingo, and

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown has decided to retire K9 Officer Dingo from the police department; and

WHEREAS, City of Allentown Police Officer Joseph Krebs has been K9 Officer Dingo's handler since December 12, 2019, and

WHEREAS, Officer Krebs has trained and worked closely with K9 Officer Dingo such that the two have formed a close bond; and

WHEREAS, Officer Krebs wishes to purchase K-9 Dingo; and

WHEREAS, the dog has negligible commercial value; and

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown wishes to sell the dog to Officer Krebs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Allentown, hereby authorize the sale of Dingo the police dog to Police Officer Joseph Krebs subject to Officer Krebs agreeing to certain conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the dog will be sold to Police Officer Joseph Krebs for private purposes as a domestic pet and not for public or private police or investigative purposes and Officer Krebs will be fully responsible for the care, maintenance, and any liability arising from the dog and will agree to indemnify the City of all future claims resulting from or caused by the dog.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute appropriate documents to effectuate the sale, and that all such documents shall be a in a form approved by the Solicitor's Office.
