HISTORY OF THE STREET PROPOSED TO BE VACATED:

The subject portion of Type Street is in the 3rd Ward. Type Street has a 11.0 Right of Way established by the Official Map of the City of Allentown prepared by G.A. Aschbach, dated 1870.

LOCATION AND CONDITION:

The subject portion of Type Street is an opened dead end public street. There are existing public utility facilities within the subject right of way. The street is impassable by vehicle due to width and dumpster storage by adjoining owners.

POLLS CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

Charles Roca, Chief of Police has not replied.

Efrain Agosto, Fire Chief has no objection to the street vacation.

Dennis Weatherhold, Communications has not replied.

LCA objects to the street vacation due to active sewer line and will need easements.

POLL ADJOINING OWNERS:

Fegley Real Estate, LLC, owners of 812 Hamilton St and 14 S 8th St have not replied.

808 W Hamilton Heights Assoc., LLC owners of 808 Hamilton St have not replied.

City Center Investment Corp., the owners of 806 Hamilton St have not replied.

Jeongsop & Jungsook Yoon, the owners of 804 Hamilton St object to the street vacation. "We want to keep access to Type Street."

Jong Kim & Yong Kim, the owners of 802 Hamilton St does not object to the street vacation.

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RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Bureau of Engineering has no objection to the subject street vacation with the condition that the City of Allentown reserves an easement over the vacated area for drainage and for passage of public utilities, together with right of entry thereon for repairs, construction and reconstruction of the drainage facilities and the public utilities without any liability for damages on the part of the City. Where the easement is reserved, no construction, temporary or permanent, shall be made over or across without the approval of the City of Allentown.




