This letter is to inform you that Gannett Fleming, Inc. is preparing to submit, on behalf of the Lehigh County Authority – Allentown Division, a permit application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for the following project:

Project Name: 30" and 36" East Side Transmission Main Repairs

Project Location: City of Allentown, Lehigh County, PA

Project Description: The Lehigh County Authority – Allentown Division proposes to repair leaks detected along their existing 30-inch and 36-inch East Side transmission mains. A total of six (6) leak sites were identified along two transmission mains. The existing transmissions mains are located along Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Little Lehigh Creek, and the Lehigh River. The proposed project is located in the City of Allentown, Lehigh County. There are four (4) study areas. The coordinates for the Run 1, Leak 1 project study area are 40° 35′ 47.24″ N; 75° 28′ 51.47″ W. The coordinates for the Run 1, Leak 2 and Run 1, Leak 3 project study area are 41° 35′ 56.51″ N; 75° 27′ 48.48″ W. The coordinates for the Run 1, Leak 4 and Run 1, Leak 5 project study area are 40° 36′ 01.47″ N; 75° 27′ 34.95″ W. The coordinates for the Run 2, Leak 1 project study area are 40° 36′ 22.79″ N; 75° 27′ 16.66″ W.

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Section 408 Permission

Section 1905-A of the Commonwealth Administrative Code, as amended by Act 14, requires that each applicant for a DEP permit must give written notice to the municipalities and the counties in which the permitted activity is located. The municipalities and counties shall receive the written notices at least 30 days before the DEP may issue or deny the permit application.



Acts 67, 68, and 127, which amended the Municipalities Planning Code, direct state agencies to consider comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances when reviewing applications for permitting of facilities and infrastructure, and specify that state agencies may rely upon comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances under certain conditions as described in Sections 619.2 and 1105 of the Municipalities Planning Code. DEP's Policy for Consideration of Local Comprehensive Plans and Zoning Ordinances in DEP Review of Permits for Facilities and Infrastructure (DEP's Land Use Policy) provides direction and guidance to DEP staff, permit applicants, and local and county governments for the implementation of Acts 67, 68, and 127 of 2000. Please do not send this form to DEP, as we must include the Municipal Land Use Letter with our permit application. If we do not receive a response from you within 30 days, we shall proceed with submission of our permit application to DEP without the Municipal Land Use Letter. If the Municipal Land Use Letter is not submitted with our permit applications and we provide proof to DEP that we attempted to obtain it, DEP will assume there are no substantive land use conflicts and proceed with the normal application review process.






