Introduced by the Administration on July 23, 2025

Approves the submission of an application for a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for construction of the Dixon Street Sidewalk and Path Project, connecting the neighborhoods with a safe travel route via sidewalks and a path. The City is asking for \$98,382.71 in grant funding with no match required.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, that

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF) will allow funds for the construction of sidewalks, a path, and handicap ramps along Dixon St and S. Delaware St, around Trout Creek Park.

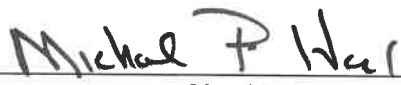
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Allentown Department of Parks and Recreation will ensure the provision of other necessary funds to make the activity feasible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the multimodal transportation fund grant will tentatively fund \$98,382.71

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate officer of the City of Allentown is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this resolution and to furnish a copy of this resolution to The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.
