Amending the 2024 Capital Fund Budget to provide for a transfer of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000.00) from Irving Pool Improvements capital project into Roosevelt Park for demolition of the old pool house building and a new pavilion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALLENTOWN:

SECTION ONE: That City Council authorizes a transfer in the following manner:
