

CITY OF ALLENTOWN

Introduced by the Administration on November 6, 2024

Authorizes the submission of a Formal Application for funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant (MTF-PennDOT) Grant Services in the amount of approximately Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for safety improvements on Hanover Avenue and East Linden Street.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund (MTF-PennDOT) Grant, for safety improvements on Hanover Avenue and East Linden Street. These safety upgrades will improve the safety and mobility of drivers and pedestrians on Hanover Avenue at the Linden Street intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Allentown City Council, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown to submit the application for approximately Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) in Multimodal Transportation Funds (MTF-PennDOT) to the Commonwealth Financing Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matt Tuerk, Mayor, and Bina Patel, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requesting grant.
