RESOLUTION

R11 - 2025

Introduced by the Administration on February 5, 2025

Authorizes the submission of a Formal Application for funding from the Bloomberg Philanthropies Initiative in the amount of approximately One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for safety improvements on Hanover Avenue and East Linden Street.

Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

WHEREAS, the City of Allentown in collaboration with the Allentown Arts Commission are desirous of obtaining funds from the Bloomberg Philanthropies Initiative, for pedestrian improvements on Irving Street. The program is designed to help cities use art and community engagement to improve street safety and revitalize public space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Allentown City Council, hereby authorizes the City of Allentown and the Allentown Arts Commission to submit the application for approximately One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to the Bloomberg Philanthropies Asphalt Art Initiative Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Allentown hereby designates Matt Tuerk, Mayor, and Bina Patel, Finance Director, as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Allentown and the Bloomberg Philanthropies to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requesting grant.
