

# CITY OF ALLENTOWN

No.\_\_ RESOLUTION R - 2023

Introduced by the Administration on April 19, 2023

Authorizes the submission of the formal application for funding from the Congresswoman Susan Wild Community Funding Project in the amount of One Million Six Hundred Twenty-Seven, Five Hundred Ninety Two Dollars (\$1,627,592) for Lehigh and Union Street and Union and 6<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Enhancement.

## Resolved by the Council of the City of Allentown, That

**WHEREAS**, the City of Allentown is desirous of obtaining funds from the Community Project Funding Grant from Congresswomen Susan Wild office, for increased mobility of the city, through the enhancement of Lehigh and Union Street and Union and 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** Currently, motorists traveling northbound on Lehigh Street are not able to turn westbound (left) on Union Street due to the intersection configuration. To address this issue, this project includes intersection upgrades including geometric widening, construction of sidewalks and crosswalks, and signalization. This would provide improved access to the ring surrounding the inner core of the city and prevents vehicles from circling and conflicting with pedestrians.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the City of Allentown will conduct the required citizen participation process.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the City of Allentown, Department of Public Works will assure the provision of other necessary funds to make the activity feasible.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Congresswoman Susan Wild Community Project Funding Grant will tentatively fund this project in its entirety if awarded the grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the appropriate officer of the City of Allentown is directed to execute a certificate attesting to the adoption of this Resolution and to furnish a copy of this Resolution to Congresswoman Susan Wild's office.
